# **Project Coordination**

#### Huntsville Creek Coldwater Conservation Plan Project

 Provided Rachel Kester-PA TU with an update on the development of the CHP and requested a 3-month extension through December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2020 to finalize the plan due to the pandemic on August 6<sup>th</sup> and it was approved on the 14<sup>th</sup>

• EPCAMR Staff and Interns conducted culvert assessments and looked for watershed issues in the Mill Creek/Gardner Creek watershed on the 5<sup>th</sup> and the 19<sup>th</sup>

#### ISI Food by Youth and Appalachian Apple Tree Planting Project in Centralia

- Provided Claudia and Pam from ISI project updates as they prepare a brief report to MIF and a budget revision
- We followed up with the grower from Heller's Orchard where we get the trees and he will not be able to get them in October as we had tentatively planned for the 17th, so we will likely still go with the cleanup on that date and push the tree planting back; He informed us that he won't be able to get them until they are pulled in early Fall possibly, so the tree planting will be pushed back a bit and a much smaller group of people will be involved in the planting due to COVID-19; We don't know what the Fall will bring yet and what our situation will be, but we can't have 200 people planting trees in close proximity to one another either from all over the place; We are considering not allowing children to participate that are under 18 and we are encouraging those individuals that are in high-risk groups and populations to consider not attending as well; We are going to purchasing masks with the logo for the tree planting, renting several wash stations, and port-a-johns for health and safety reasons as we go forward
- We are anticipating still giving away 150 apple trees to residents in the Wyoming Valley

• Discussed with Ed Wytovich and Ken Klemow, EPCAMR Board Members the topic of the potential to plant trees on back-end dumped soil in Centralia along the Old 61 Highway, should Pagnotti take it under consideration in the future; Soil samples would need to be taken and an average depth of the piles measured in the future; Ed is willing to park at the lower end and work uphill, digging every 100 yds or so and taking soil samples from each hole, then doing the same for the southbound lanes, measuring depth using a straightedge and a ruler, logging data, and carrying soil samples
